

## PVYC COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS

**BOATYARD COMMITTEE** Jason Kology, Chair 413-566-2243

Supervise, maintain and improve all boatyard storage areas, boat launching/hauling and vehicle parking areas and club roads. The boat committee also works on special projects and improvements to the club. Expertise with carpentry, masonry, electrical or plumbing wanted.

**DOCK COMMITTEE** David Grant, Chair 413-566-8271

Responsible for maintaining dock sections, anchors and the mooring field. Prep all units during April by having Saturday work parties until docks are ready. Docks/moorings usually go in for the season on the first Saturday in May, and out on the last Saturday in October.

**GROUNDS COMMITTEE** John Mientus, Chair 860-749-0381

Supervise and maintain club grounds, arrange for grass cutting, tree pruning, clearing of underbrush and general improvement of club property. Maintain picnic area and general policing of club grounds (excluding pool and boatyard areas). Duties include: gutter cleaning, branch/limb collection, rubbish barrel emptying and cleaning, and spring mulching. **Members should have riding lawn mower experience.**

**HOUSE COMMITTEE** Ali Clifford, Chair 860-454-4281

Oversee care, maintenance, general repair and use of PVYC Clubhouse.

**RACE COMMITTEE** John Dalsey, Chair 413-563 2477

Supervise all yacht racing activities. Arrange the racecourse, maintain scoring, arrange protest/horns/timers and keep accurate records of the results of all races. Committee members will officiate during the PVYC Summer Racing Series (held last season on Sundays at 1:30pm). Shifts will last about 3 hours. Two committee members will be assigned each weekend to set up course, start/time race and record results.

**SOCIAL COMMITTEE**      Cyndie Eisnor, Chair      860-731-0812

Plan and manage all social events at the PVYC as well as Memorial Day, July 4<sup>th</sup> and Labor Day picnics. The committee also provides refreshments for PVYC members participating in work party days.

**POOL COMMITTEE**      Bud Breeding, Chair      413-567-7957

In addition to assisting in opening and closing the pools each season, committee members routinely maintain the pool deck, the pool area lawn and fence, locker rooms, pool area furniture, and filtering equipment. Experience with concrete, plaster, tile work, and/or a general mechanical aptitude would be helpful. Although there are a few ongoing maintenance projects throughout the summer season, the bulk of this committee's work is done in the spring to prepare and open the pools for the season. **Availability and willingness to work during the pool opening process (late April-May) is important.**
